To date, MCAS has not received approval from College Board regarding requested accommodations for the SAT for some students. Parents/guardians of students this is affecting were contacted to determine if the student will participate in the SAT with the requested accommodations. It was explained to the parent/guardian that if the student participates with accommodations, which have not been approved by College Board, the scores from said testing cannot be submitted to colleges or universities for admission consideration.
